What's New in FY 2018

Three Standing Notices

Starting with the FY 2018 CoC Program Registration, there are three separate Registration Notices that will be in effect for the foreseeable future. The Notices are available on the HUD Exchange [FY 2018 Continuum of Care \(CoC\) Program Competition: Funding Availability page](#).

Three Registration Notices

- Collaborative Applicant Registration Notice
- Unified Funding Agency (UFA) Registration Notice
- High Performing Community (HPC) Registration Notice

A Note about *e-snaps*

In *e-snaps*, there is still only one CoC Registration process for all Collaborative Applicants. On screen 1 of the CoC Registration forms, you will indicate whether you are registering as a CA or applying to for UFA or HPC status. [Log in to e-snaps](#).

Who is required to submit CoC Registration in *e-snaps*?

1. ONLY Collaborative Applicants, NOT project applicants
(i.e., NOT organizations who will be submitting the project applications)
2. Only SOME Collaborative Applicants

Required

- Organization designated as the Collaborative Applicant has changed from FY 2017
- CoCs have merged
- Geographic codes or areas in the CoC have changed
- CoC is applying for UFA designation
*** Must reapply every year or will lose designation**
- CoC is applying for HPC designation

NOT Required

- CoC has **no** changes from the previous year's CoC Program Competition



What HUD Will Do

If the CoC does not complete the forms, HUD will move information from the previous year's CoC Program Registration forward with **no changes** (see Section I of the [CoC Program Registration Notice](#)).
