

HOME Expiring Funds Report Explanations

- 1. Fiscal Year (FY)** – the fiscal year of the HOME grant with a balance of HOME funds that can be committed and/or expended.
- 2. State (ST)** – the state in which the HOME participating jurisdiction (PJ) is located.
- 3. PJ** – the name of the HOME PJ that has a balance to commit and/or draw.
- 4. Funding Source** – the name of the entity that subgranted HOME funds to a sub-recipient (e.g. the PJ or a state-recipient).
- 5. Recipient of Funds** – the entity that received the HOME funds. This can be a PJ with an EN balance or a balance in a subfund, or can be an entity receiving HOME funds from the PJ directly or from a state-recipient.
- 6. Recipient UOG Code** – a unique number that identifies a specific recipient.
- 7. UOG Number** –
- 8. Recipient Type** –
 - CO – CHDO
 - LG – Local Government
 - OE – Other Entity (sub-recipient)
 - SE – State Entitlement
 - SR – State Recipient
- 9. Fund Type** – the types of funds.
 - AD – Administration
 - CC – CHDO Capacity
 - CL – CHDO Loan
 - CO – CHDO Operating
 - CR – CHDO Reservation
 - EN – Entitlement
 - SU – Subgrant to State-recipients or Sub-recipient
- 10. Authorized Amount** – the total amount of HOME funds the recipient is authorized to commit and draw.
- 11. Balance to Draw** – the amount of HOME funds left available from the “Authorized Amount” that can be drawn for activities.
- 12. Balance to Commit** – the amount of HOME funds left available from the “Authorized Amount” that can be committed to activities.
