### *POPULATION: PERSONS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS<sup>1</sup>*

The state has 3 Continuums of Care including one for Balance of State. Nevada experienced the largest increases in the number of homeless individuals between 2013 and 2014 with an additional 1,733 individuals.<sup>2</sup>

### *POPULATION: LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS AND THOSE LIVING IN POVERTY*

#### Numbers of Persons Below the Poverty Line<sup>3</sup>

Nevada has a poverty rate of 15% of its population having incomes below the Federal Poverty Level (2009-2013). The national poverty rate for this same period was 15.4%.

#### **POPULATION: PERSONS LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS<sup>6</sup>**

- The estimated adult and adolescent population living with diagnosed HIV infection, regardless of stage of disease, in Nevada in 2011 was 6,894. Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Clients in NV in 2012 Income and Housing Status
  - 63.1% (1,413) have incomes below the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
  - 5.3% (139) are homeless or in unstable housing
  - 6.2% (161) are in temporary housing
  - 88.5% (2,309) are in stable/permanent housing
