## Summer Jobs and Beyond: Career Pathways for Youth (CPY)

**Benefit Type:** Grant Competition

**Eligible Communities:** Urban, rural, tribal

**Funding Availability:** The Department of Labor announced the award of \$21 million in grant funds to 11 communities on May 16, 2016.

**Benefits to Promise Zone:** Priority Consideration

**Program Description:** CPY grants were awarded to 10 local workforce development boards and one WIOA Section 166 grantees serving tribal populations. These grants will provide summer and year-round part-time job opportunities for in-school youth and employment and work experience opportunities throughout the year for young people who are out of school and work, in addition to exposure to career pathways in in-demand job sectors. Grants are funding projects that provide increased service delivery to eligible participants through partnership collaboration and a focus on building out innovative strategies to help young people transition from summer jobs into year-round work and career pathways.

**Eligibility/Target Population:** Eligible participants are in-school youth and out-of-school youth, ages 16-24, with limited or no work experience.
