Eligible Applicants: SEAs, LEAs, Indian tribes, Indian organizations, federally supported elementary and secondary schools for Indian students, and Indian institutions, including Indian IHEs, or a consortium of such institutions.

Funding Availability: For FY16, Department of Education estimates that \$500K to \$1M will be made available, which is estimated to fund 19 new awards.

Benefits to Promise Zone: Priority Consideration

Goal: The Native Youth Community Projects (NYCP) is centered on the goal of ensuring that Indian students are prepared for college and careers by promoting partnerships in American Indian and Alaska Native tribal communities.

Program Description: This program is designed to improve the education opportunities and achievement of preschool, elementary, and secondary school Indian children by developing, testing, and demonstrating effective services and programs.

Any configuration of entities can participate in a partnership under the NYCP priority as long as: 1) the lead applicant is an eligible entity; 2) the partnership includes the required partners, which are at least one tribe (or its TEA) and at least one LEA or BIE-funded school; and 3) at least one partner has demonstrated capacity to improve student outcomes that are relevant to the project focus, in accordance with the definition of NYCP. Each project may include any other optional entities that will be helpful for the project's success.
