

Depending on the size and composition of your local CoC, it is possible that a variety of leaders and stakeholders will be involved in the planning and execution of the PIT count. Be sure that all people responsible for leading the PIT count in your community complete this training. This includes: the CoC collaborative applicant, the HMIS lead, the Consolidated Plan, or Con Plan, jurisdiction leaders, other CoC members, and other local stakeholders involved in planning and executing the PIT count.

The goals of the PIT Count online training are to help participants gain a general understanding of the PIT count minimum standards, the PIT Count Methodology Guide and its supplementary tools, and the approved methodologies for sheltered and unsheltered counts.
