

HUD's PIT Count Methodology Guide includes information on what should go into a PIT count plan. These include:

- the CoC's methodologies for conducting the sheltered and unsheltered PIT count,
- the development of a data quality plan,
- the identification and confirmation of locations to count sheltered and unsheltered people,
- the development of surveys,
- what roles volunteers will play, how they will be recruited, and what training will take place,
- if and how incentives will be used,
- PIT count committee membership, roles, and responsibilities,
- date and time for the count,
- the intent and scope of the activities on the night of the count and any relevant count approaches occurring in the following 7-day period, and
- how the count will be publicized.
